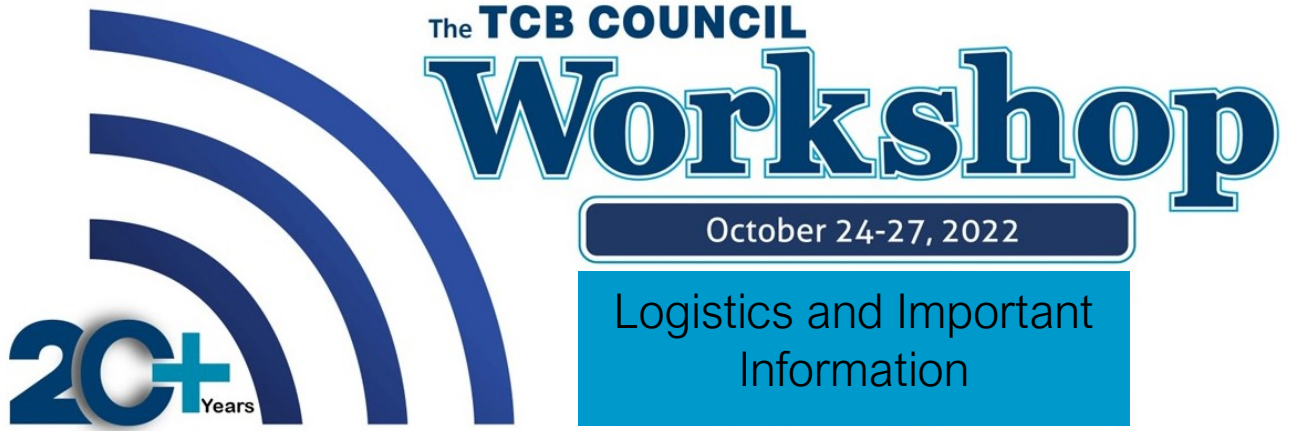
**Member Discounts.** Members of the TCB Council login to receive your discount for each paid registration. In-person seats will be limited so send in your registration now.

## Accommodations
